**NOTICE INVITING E-BIDDING
(Single stage single envelope E-Bidding System)**

Pakhtunkhwa Highways Authority invites electronic Bids from eligible firms /contractors in accordance with KPPRA procurement Rules 2014 on “**Single Stage Single Envelope**” E-Bidding procedure for the following works. The Bidders should be registered with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority (KPRa) and Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) and PKHA for the year 2020-21 in relevant category & field of specialization. The firms having adequate financial soundness, relevant experience, personnel capabilities, required equipment and other requirements as included in ITB can participate in the tenders:


II. Bidding documents including Priced BOQ / Engineer Estimate, instruction to bidders (ITB), preamble, evaluation criteria etc. are available on PKHA web site (www.pkha.gov.pk) which can be downloaded before opening date and submit it along with bid, otherwise bids submitted without these documents will be considered as non-responsive.

III. All bidders are required to be registered with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority (KPRa), established under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Finance Act, 2013 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. xxi of 2013), for works, consulting and non-consulting services as listed in schedule-ii of the act ibid.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS (ITB)

1. The bidder shall submit through courier 2% Bid security of the Engineering Estimated Cost, sealed in envelop, in the shape of call deposit or bank guarantee (in original) before closing date and time.
2. In case of bid/rate quoted by the bidders more than 10% below the Engineers estimate, an additional bid security shall be sought from the successful bidder only to the extent of bid more than 10% Below the Engineer estimate in the form of percentage. The amount of additional bid security shall be equal to the impact of Financial difference occurring in the quoted rates beyond 10% below Engineer Estimate.
3. The procuring entity may offer the contract to the next lowest bidder after due diligence in the context of financial difference between such two bids and the market analysis in order to discourage cartel making and to protect public interest at large.
4. Electronic bids should be submitted electronically on or before the fixed date/time.
5. The bidders are required to quote their rates (electronically) "ABOVE / BELOW / AT PAR" for both priced BOQ / Engineer Estimate based on MRS-2020 and NSI Items as well. Only two digits after the decimal point shall be considered for evaluation purpose.
6. All the information and documents provided by the bidder must be based on facts beyond any doubt. During analysis / scrutiny or evaluation of the proposals any misrepresentation, false statement or fake document would make a ground for rejection of the bid and will also be liable for debarment / blacklisting. Any fake document or misrepresentation detected during the currency of the contract, will render the firm to be black listed and would be reported to the PEC for cancellation of their registration/license.
7. Electronic Bids will be valid for Ninety (90) days.
8. Successful Bidder should sign the agreement with the department within Twenty-Eight (28) days after issuance of Work Order.
9. Call Deposit and bank guarantee of Scheduled Banks shall be acceptable.
10. If the evaluated electronic bid costs of two or more than two bidders are equal, then the successful bid will be declared through open draw.
11. Electronic Bids will be opened in PKHA board room after 30 minutes of closing time in the presence of bidders / their representative who choose to be present.
12. The employer has the authority to reject any bid or all the bids on assigning cogent reasons.
13. Bid security of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd lowest bidders for the specific work will be retained by the Department till the approval of bids.
