**2ND TIME NOTICE INVITING E-BIDDING
(Single stage one envelope E-Bidding System)**

Pakhtunkhwa Highways Authority invites electronic Bids from eligible firms /contractors in accordance with KPPRA procurement Rules 2014 on single stage one envelope E-Bidding procedure for the following works. The firms already enlisted with PKHA having adequate financial soundness, relevant experience, personnel capabilities, required equipments and others requirement as included in ITB can participate in the tenders:

II. Priced BOQ / Engineer Estimate, instruction to bidders (ITB), are available on PKHA web site (www.pkha.gov.pk).

III. The Bidders should be registered with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority (KPRA) and Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) in relevant category & field of specialization.


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CONDITIONS TO BIDDERS (ITB)

- a. Bid security 2% of the Estimated Cost in shape of call deposit or bank guarantee (in original) in the name of MD-PKHA shall be sealed in separate envelop clearly marked as "Bid Security" addressed to MD-PKHA Peshawar and shall be submitted through Pakistan Post / UMS / Courier before closing time failing which the bid will be considered as non responsive. The bidders who quoted their bids / rates more than 10% below the Engineer's estimate shall provide an additional bid security in form of CDR equivalent to the percent amount of more than 10% below.
 - b. The successful bidder shall be bound to provide the Additional Bid Security within 3 working days from the issuance of Letter of Acceptance, failing which the P.E shall forfeit the bid security of successful bidder and may also initiate legal proceeding against the bidder who repudiated the contract under KPPRA procurement rules. The P.E may offer the contract to next lowest bidder covered by the KPPRA notification.
2. The bidders are required to quote their rates (electronically) "ABOVE / BELOW / AT PAR" for both priced BOQ / Engineer Estimate based on MRS-2019 and NSI Items as well. Only two digits after the decimal point shall be considered for evaluation purpose.
 3. Photocopies of valid registration of PEC & KPRA, photocopy of CNIC & Form-H of the Company should be annexed with bid security.
 4. All other items not mentioned in the BOQ but exist in the MRS-2019 shall be paid at contractor's rate approved by the Competent Authority with approved area cost factor.
 5. The Successful bidder shall be subjected to all admissible taxes including stamp duty, service charges, sale tax and any other at prevailing rate.
 6. Financial bid shall be filled online. Complete bid must reach these offices on or before the fixed date time.
 7. Time allowed for the completion of the work as specified in the NIT shall start from the issuance of Work Order.
 8. Electronic Bids validity period is 90-days.
 9. The successful bidder will provide performance security within 14-days after receipt of Letter of Acceptance (LOA), in case the contract value becomes equal or more than Rs. 20.000 million.
 10. Successful Bidder should sign the agreement with PKHA within Twenty Eight (28) days after issuance of Letter of Acceptance.
 11. Call Deposit and bank guarantee of Scheduled Banks shall be acceptable.
 12. If the evaluated electronic bid costs of two or more than two bidders are equal then the successful bid will declared through open draw.
 13. Bids will be opened in PKHA HQ after 30 minutes of closing time in the presence of bidders / their representative who choose to be present.
 14. The Procuring Entity has the authority to reject any bid or all the bids assigning cogent reasons.
 15. Bid security of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd lowest bidders for the specific work will be retained by the Authority till the approval of bids.
 16. All the information and documents provided by the bidder must be based on facts beyond any doubt. Any misrepresentation, false statement or fake document found in the proposal at any stage, would lead to debarment / blacklisting of the firm. The matter may also be reported to the PEC for cancellation of registration/license of the respective firm.


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
