3. All bidders are required to be registered with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority (KPRRA) and with Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) for the Year 2020 – 21 in relevant Category & Field of Specialization.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS
(Single Stage Single Envelop E-Bidding System)

- Bid Security (**2% of the Estimated Cost**) in the shape of Call Deposit (CDR) or Bank Guarantee (in original) shall be provided before closing time.
2. Financial Bid should be submitted online / electronically and CDR (in original) & other relevant documents should reach in this office in sealed envelope on or before the closing date & time.
 3. Electronic Bids will be displayed Online on E-Bidding System after 30 minutes of closing time in the presence of bidders / their representatives who chose to be present.
 4. In case of Bid / Rate quoted by the bidder more than 10% below Engineer Estimate, the Additional Bid Security shall be sought from the successful bidder only to the extent of bid more than 10% Below Engineer Estimate in the form of percentage. The amount of Additional Bid Security shall be equal to the impact of financial difference occurring in the quoted rates beyond 10% Below Engineer Estimate. The successful bidder shall be bound to provide the Additional Bid Security within 3 working days from the issuance of letter of Acceptance, failing which the Procuring Entity shall forfeit the Bid Security of the successful bidder and may also initiate legal proceedings against the bidder who repudiated the contract under KPPRA Procurement Rules. The Procuring Entity may offer the contract to next lowest bidder covered by the KPPRA Notification.
 5. The bidder are required to quote their rates (electronically) "ABOVE / BELOW / AT PAR" for both priced BOQ / Engineer Estimate based on MRS applicable and NSI Items as well. Only two digits after the decimal point shall be considered for evaluation purpose.
 6. Any bidder who provides incorrect information shall stand disqualified & de-barred.
 7. Time allowed for the completion of the work as specified in the NIT shall start from the issuance of Work Order.
 8. Electronic Bids validity period is 90-days.
 9. Successful Bidder should sign the agreement with the department within Twenty Eight (28) days after issuance of Work Order.
 10. Call Deposit and bank guarantee of Scheduled Banks shall be acceptable.
 11. If the evaluated electronic bid costs of two or more than two bidders are equal then the successful bid will declared through open draw
 12. The employer has the authority to reject any bid or all the bids assigning cogent reasons.
 13. Bid security of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd lowest bidders for the each work will be retained by the Department till the approval of bid.
 14. The successful bidder shall be subjected to all admissible taxes including stamp duty, service charges, sales tax & any other at prevailing rates.
 15. The Contractor will deposit Performance Security (*In shape of CDR / Bank Guarantee (valid for one year in case of Bank Guarantee)*) within fourteen (14) days after receipt of Letter of Acceptance, in case the contract value is equal to or exceeds Rs. 20.00 million

All bidders are required to be registered with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority (KPRA) established under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Finance Act, 2013 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. XXI or" 2013), for works, consulting and non-consulting services as listed in Schedule – II of the Act ibid.


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
