***(Single Stage Single Envelope E-Bidding System)***

Pakhtunkhwa Highways Authority (PKHA) invites Electronic Bids from eligible firms / contractors in accordance with KPPRA Procurement Rules 2014 on, “**Single Stage Single Envelope**” E-Bidding Procedure for the following works. The bidders should be registered with Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) for the Year 2020 – 21 in relevant Category & Field of Specialization. The firms already enlisted with PKHA having adequate financial soundness, relevant experience, personnel capabilities, required equipments and other requirements as included in ITB can participate in the tender.

These documents can also be obtained from the office of the Deputy Director (Procurement) PKHA Peshawar before opening date and submit it along with bid, otherwise bids submitted without these documents will be considered as non-responsive.
2. All bidders are required to be registered with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority (KPR) (Active Status).

**(SINGLE STAGE SINGLE ENVELOPE BIDDING SYSTEM CONDITIONS/ITB)**

1. Bid Security (2% of the Estimated Cost) in the shape of Call Deposit (CDR) or Bank Guarantee (in original) shall be provided before closing time and must be uploaded on E-Bidding System.
2. Cost of Tender form (@0.03% of Estimated Cost) (Non-refundable) in the shape of Call Deposit (CDR) (in original) shall be provided before closing time, vide Notification No. SO(B)/1-102/CMD/CS/PBC/2020-21/C&WD dated 12/04/2021.
3. Financial Bid should be submitted online/electronically and CDR (in original) & other relevant documents should reach in this office in sealed envelope on or before the closing date & time.
4. Electronic Bids will be displayed Online on E-Bidding System after 30 minutes of closing time in the presence of bidders/their representatives who chose to be present.
5. The contractors quoting their bids upto a limit of 15% below Engineer Estimate shall submit Bid Security to the extent of 2% of Engineer Estimate only.
6. The contractor quoting their bids more that 15% below on Engineer's Estimate shall submit along their bids as *Additional Security* to the extent of their bid/rates more that 15% below on Engineer Estimate in the form of percentage.
7. In case the bidder quotes more than 15% below the Engineer Estimate and the bid is not accompanied by the Additional Security then the bid shall be considered as *Non-Responsive* and the 2<sup>nd</sup> lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.
8. In case a contractor quotes more than 30% below Engineer Estimate, the procuring entity shall, in addition to additional security, require the contractor to produce detailed rate analysis of his bid price in relation to any or all the items of BOQ, Scope of Work, allocation of risks and responsibilities and/or any other requirements of the bid solicitation document. The contract shall be awarded to the lowest evaluated bidder who has satisfied the procuring entity on rate analysis. However, if the procuring entity determines that the contractor has failed to demonstrate its capability to execute the contract all the offered price, the matter shall be referred to the next higher authority for rejection of the bid on the basis of being financially unviable.
9. If the successful contractor who has quoted a rate more than 10% below on the Engineer Estimate and has repudiated the contract, the entire security deposit i.e. 2% bid security along with 8% additional bid security shall be forfeited in favor of the Government.
10. The bidder are required to quote their rates (electronically) "ABOVE / BELOW / AT PAR" for both priced BOQ / Engineer Estimate based on MRS -2020 applicable and NSI Items as well. Only two digits after the decimal point shall be considered for evaluation purpose.
11. Any bidder who provides incorrect information shall stand disqualified & de-barred.
12. Time allowed for the completion of the work as specified in the NIT shall start from the issuance of Work Order.
13. Electronic Bids validity period is 90-days.
14. Successful Bidder should sign the agreement with the department within Twenty Eight (28) days after issuance of Work Order.
15. Call Deposit and bank guarantee of Scheduled Banks shall be acceptable.
16. If the evaluated electronic bid costs of two or more than two bidders are equal then the successful bid will declared through open draw
17. The employer has the authority to reject any bid or all the bids assigning cogent reasons.
18. Bid security of the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> lowest bidders for the each work will be retained by the Department till the approval of bid.
19. The successful bidder shall be subjected to all admissible taxes including stamp duty, service charges, sales tax & any other at prevailing rates.
20. The Contractor will deposit Performance Security (*In shape of CDR / Bank Guarantee (valid for one year in case of Bank Guarantee)*) within fourteen (14) days after receipt of Letter of Acceptance, in case the contract value is equal to or exceeds Rs. 20.00 million
