- Complete Details of Bid Security in shape of CDR/Bank Guarantee i.e., Bank Name, instrument number(s) and date(s) must be submitted Electronically along-with the E-bid on the E-bidding System.
- Bids must be accompanied by a non-refundable Tender Fee @ 0.03% of the Engineer's Estimate; in the shape of CDR, as per instructions issued by Section Officer (Confidential) Chief Minister's Secretariat vide letter No. SO(C) CMS/KPK/2021/2828/35/W/E dated 05/04/2021.
- The bidders quoting more than 15% on Engineer Estimate shall submit along-with their bid Additional Security to the extent of their bid / rate quoted beyond 15%
- All bidders are required to be registered with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority (KPRA) under Finance Act, 2013 Act No. XXI of 2013

**INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS**  
**(Single Stage Two Envelop E-bidding System)**

1. Technical proposal should accompany the following documents: -
  - a. **Bid Security, Additional Security (in case of below) and Stamp Duty** in the shape of Call Deposit/ Bank Guarantee (Issued from Schedule Bank shall be accepted.) (**Original as well as Photo-Copy**)
  - b. Enlistment with C&W Department (Photocopy)
  - c. Renewal of Registration for Current Financial Year (Photocopy)
  - d. National Identity Card [CNIC] (Photocopy)
  - e. Valid Pakistan Engineering Council registration copy for the Current Calendar Year (CCY)
  - f. Form H (in case of Company / Firm).
  - g. Documents showing General Capabilities, Financial Soundness, General & Relevant Record, Personnel Capabilities, Equipment Capabilities, Registration with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority (KPRA) and Income Tax / NTN Certificates etc.
  - h. Any other documents to support the Technical Bid.
2. A copy of the Technical Proposal in the required format is mandatory to be uploaded as a part of E-Bidding before submitting Financial Bid; Scanned copy of Bid Security shall be submitted electronically along-with Technical Bid on E-Bidding system. Separate Technical Proposal shall be submitted for each work. Specialized Codes where required shall be ascertained by the Contractor before applying for Tender/Submission of Tender Documents.
3. The contractors quoting their bids up-to a limit of 15% below Engineer estimate shall submit Bid Security to the extent of 2% of Engineer Estimate only.
4. The Contractors quoting their bids more than 15% below on Engineer's Estimate shall submit along-with their Bid an Additional Security (in shape of CDR) to the extent of the percentage difference in their quoted rates & 15 % below of Engineer's Estimate.
5. In case the Bidder quotes more than 15% below the Engineer Estimates and the bid is not accompanied by the Additional Security then the Bid shall be considered as non-Responsive and the 2<sup>nd</sup> Lowest Bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.
6. In case a contractor quotes more than 30% below on Engineer's Estimate, the Procuring Entity shall, in addition to additional security, require the Contractor to provide detailed rate analysis of his bid price, methodology, and other requirements to ascertain the workability and viability of the quoted rates. If the procuring Entity determines that the contractor has failed to demonstrate, as above, its capability to execute the contract at the offered price, the matter shall be referred to the next higher authority for rejection of the bid on the basis of being non-workable. The contract shall then be awarded to the next lowest Evaluated Bidder (and so on) who has satisfied the Procuring Entity.
7. The procuring entity may offer the contract to next Lowest Bidder after due diligence in the context of financial difference between such two bids or may advertise procurement afresh.
8. After commencements of work by the successful bidder, the Procuring Entity may replace the Additional Security with a Bank Guarantee of the same amount from the Scheduled Bank; if the already deposited security is not in the form of Bank Guarantee.
9. The Additional Security shall be released to the Contractor in four installments i.e., 25% to be released upon completion of 25% of the project. 50% to be released upon completion of 50% of the project. 75% to be released upon completion of 75% of the project and the remaining amount to be released after completion of the project.
10. Any effort toward cartel making shall be considered as violation of Rule-44 and shall be attributed towards mis-procurement under Rule-54 of Procurement Rules *ibid*.
11. Technical proposal should be in sealed envelope clearly marked "Technical Proposal" and Additional Security (in case of quoted rates more than 15% below) should be in sealed envelope accompanied with signed BOQ clearly marked "Financial Bid". Technical proposal and financial bid shall reach the Bids opening venue before the fixed date / time.
12. Financial bid shall be filled online. Complete Bids must reach to the office on or before the fixed date/time.
13. The Bidders are required to quote their rates above or below on both MRS as well as on non MRS items.
14. Technical Evaluation will be carried out with Pass/Fail threshold, Passing Criteria includes, PEC Registration, Enlistment with C&W Department, Active Tax Payer, Relevant Experience in past 05 years, and present Performance, Technical Personnel, required Equipment, Financial status, Auditor's Report, Managerial Capabilities, Litigation status etc. as mentioned in Application Forms 1-9 already available on C&W Website.
15. Any Bidder who provides Incorrect information found at any stage shall stand disqualified & debarred.
16. Any Bidder who submits fake or forged documents or information shall be debarred.
17. Time allowed for the completion of the work as specified in the NIE the date of commencement will be reckoned from the issuance of Work Order.
18. Electronic Bids will be valid for 90 days on to the extended period as per KPPRA SBD days after.
19. Successful Bidder must sign the Contract Agreement with the C&W Department with-in Twenty-Eight (28) days after issuance of Work Order.
20. Call Deposit of only Scheduled Banks shall be accepted.
21. If the evaluated Electronic Bid cost of two or more than two bidders is equal then the successful bidders will be declared through **draw**.
22. Technical Bids will be opened after 30 minutes of closing time in the presence of Bidders / their Representatives who choose to be present.
23. The Procuring Entity has the right to reject any bid or all the bid assigning valid reasons.
24. Bid security of the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> bidder shall be retained by the Procuring Entity till the approval of the bid.
25. All interested eligible bidders shall deposit their CDRs in the name of the procurement entity five days prior the closing date of bid submission. The procuring entity shall ensure that bids of only those bidders be opened whose security deposit has been credited to the official account before opening of the bids. In case no security deposit is credit the bids shall be considered non-responsive and summarily be rejected.
26. For other instructions and details, the KPPRA SBDs Part I; Instructions to Bidders should be followed.
