
NOTICE INVITING E-BIDDING

C & W Department (Division, District Battagram), Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa invites electronic Bids from eligible firms /contractor in accordance with KPPRA procurement Rules 2014 on single stage single envelop procedure for the following works.

1. Bid documents and instruction to bidders can be downloaded from C&W web site (www.cwd.gkp.pk) and from the office of undersigned on demand before the submission date/time.
2. Scanned copy of bid security shall be submitted electronically along with the bid on E-bidding system.
3. Venue of Bids opening is office of the undersigned.
4. In case of bid more than 15% below, the bidders shall submit additional bid security in light of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement Regulatory Authority Notification No.S.R.O.(13)/Vol:1-21/2021-22/5335-48 dated 15-09-2021 which is available in the KPPRA web site.
5. As per C&W Secretariat Notification No.SO(B)I-102/CMD/PBC/2020-21/C&WD dated 12-04-2021 the bidding entry fee @0.03% of the tender cost must be attached in shape of Bank Draft which will be non-refundable at the time of bid submission.
6. "All bidders are required to be register with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority, established under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Finance Act,2013 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No.XXI of 2013), for works, consulting and non-consulting services as listed in schedule-II of the Act ibid".



INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS.

(Single Stage Single Envelop E-bidding System)


1. The bidder shall submit 2% Bid Security of the Estimated Cost in the shape of deposit at call (original) before half an hour before closing date and time.
2. As per Govt:of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement Regulatory Authority Notification No. **S.R.O.(13)/Vol:1-21/2021-22/5335-48 dated 15-09-2021 which is available in the KPPRA web site.**
i.e. In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 35-A of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement Regulatory Authority Act, 2012 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. XI of 2012) the Authority has been pleased to issue the following regulation, namely: -
 1. **Short title and commencement.-** (i) This regulation may be called the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement Regulation No. XIII 2021.
(ii) This shall come into force at once.
 2. **Matters pertaining to Additional Security in case of abnormally low bids.-** This regulation relates to the matters pertaining to Additional Security submitted by the bidders who quote their bids more than 15% below on Engineer Estimate in procurement of works.
 - i. The contractors quoting their bids up to a limit of 15% below Engineer estimate shall submit bid security to the extent of 2% of Engineer Estimate only.
 - ii. The contractors quoting their bids more than 15% below on Engineer's Estimate shall submit along with their bids an **Additional Security** to the extent of their bid/rates more than 15% below on engineer estimate in the form of percentage.
 - iii. In case the bidder quotes more than 15% below the Engineer Estimate and the bid is not accompanied by the Additional Security then the bid shall be considered as non-responsive and the 2nd lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.
 - iv. In case a contractor quotes more than 30% below on Engineer Estimate, the procuring entity shall, in addition to additional security, require the contractor to produce detailed rate analysis of his bid price in relation to any or all the items of bill of quantities, scope of work, allocation of risks and responsibilities and/or any other requirements of the bid solicitation document. The contract shall be awarded to the lowest evaluated bidder who has satisfied the procuring entity on rate analysis. However, if the procuring entity determines that the contractor has failed to demonstrate its capability to execute the contract at the offered price, the matter shall be referred to the next higher authority for rejection of the bid on the basis of being financially unviable.
 - v. The procuring entity may offer the contract to next lowest bidder after due diligence in the context of financial difference between such two bids or may advertise procurement opportunity afresh.


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- vi. After commencements of work by the successful bidder, the procuring entity may replace the Additional Security with a bank guarantee of the same amount from the scheduled bank; if the already deposited security is not in the form of bank guarantee.
 - vii. The Additional Security shall be released to the contractor in four installments that is 25% to be released upon completion of 25% of the project, 50% to be released upon completion of 50% of the project, 75% to be released upon completion of 75% of the project and the remaining amount to be released after completion of the project.
 - viii. All previous orders, instructions and regulations issued regarding additional security shall stand superseded.
3. Electronic Bids should be submitted electronically on or before the fixed date/time.
 4. Electronic Bidding shall be done on "Above/Below" system on BOQ/Engineer's estimate, based on the MRS applicable. Only two digits after the decimal point shall be considered for evaluation purpose.
 5. Any bidder who provides incorrect information shall stand disqualified and will be debarred.
 6. Time allowed for completion of the work is as specified in the NIT which will start from the issuance of LOA.
 7. Electronic Bids will valid for Ninety (90) days.
 8. Successful Bidder should sign the agreement with the department within Twenty Eight (28) days after acceptance of bid.
 9. Call Deposit of Scheduled Banks shall be acceptable.
 10. If the evaluated electronic bid costs of two or more than two bidders are equal then the successful bidder will be declared through draw.
 11. Electronic Bids will be displayed by Online E-Bidding System after 30 minutes of closing time in the presence of bidders/ their representatives who chose to be present.
 12. The employer has the authority to reject any E-bid or all the E-bids assigning valid reason.
 13. Bid security of 1st, 2nd and 3rd lowest bidders will be retained by the employer till approval of bid.
 14. Pay order shall not be accepted as per KPPRA Notification No.KPPRA/M&E/Estt:/1-12/2017-2018 dated 05-04-2018. **(The above instruction to bidders has been revised in light of the KPPRA Rules 2014. The same was discussed with the Secretary to Govt: of KPK C&W Department Peshawar and approved for circulation to the field office for immediate implementation vide Chief Engineer(North) C&W Department Peshawar No.1120/1-T dated 05-11-2018).**
 15. AS PER MINUTES OF THE MEETING REGARDING STANDARD N.I.T. UNDER THE CHAIRMAN SHIP OF SECRETARY C&W DEPARTMENT ON 3-8-2018 VIDE DIRECOR P&M C&W DEPARTMENT No. D(P&M)/C&WD/1043/2018 DATED 17-8-2018 RECEIVED IN THIS OFFICE VIDE SUPERINTENDING ENGINEER(HQ)OFFICE OF THE CHIEF ENGINEER (EAST) C&W DEPARTMENT ABBOTTABAD NO.1840/2-M DATED 17-9-2018, THE FOLLOWING CONDITION WILL BE ADDED IN THE STANDARD NIT;-
 - (a) "Bidders who submit their financial bids without a valid C.D. will be debarred from Participating in bidding process for one year.
 - (b) The bidder should be enlisted with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority, as per KPPRA rules.
 16. As per C&W Secretariat Notification No.SO(B)I-102/CMD/PBC/2020-21/C&WD dated 12-04-2021 the bidding entry fee @0.03% of the tender cost must be attached in shape of Bank Draft which will be non-refundable at the time of bid submission.


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
