NOTICE INVITING E-BIDDING

C&W Department Office of the Executive Engineer Highway Division-1 Peshawar Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa invites Electronic Bids from the eligible firms/bidders in accordance with KPPRA procurement rules 2014 on single stage two envelop procedure for the below mentioned work.

- Bid documents and instruction to Bidders can be downloaded up to one day prior to the opening date from C&W web site www.cwd.gkp.pk. KPPRA Website.
- The contractors quoting their bids up to a limit of 10% below Engineer Estimate shall submit bid security @2% only Of Engineer Estimate.
- Nonrefundable bidding entry fee @0.03% of tender cost notified vide Section Officer (Confidential) Chief Minister's Secretariat Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar No. SO(C)/CMS/KPK/2021/2828-31 dated 05-04-2021.
- The contractors quoting their bids more than 10% below up to 20% below on Engineers' Estimate shall submit along with their bids 8% Additional Security of Engineer's Estimated cost in addition 2% bid security. If the bid is not accompanied with the required amount of additional security then it will be considered as non-responsive and the 2% bid security shall be forfeited in favour of Government and the 2nd lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.
- [Similarly, a contractor quoting bid more than 20% below shall submit with his bid an additional security on Engineer's estimated cost equal to the differential amount of submitted bid and Engineers' Estimate along with detail rate analysis]. In case of more than 20% below bids, if the bid is not accompanied by the detail rate analysis and /or required amount of additional security, then the said bid shall be considered as non-responsive. All the securities submitted along with such non-responsive bid shall be forfeited in favour of Govt and the 2nd lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.
- In case detail rate analysis submitted with the bids is in view of the procuring Entity, non-convincing, the Head of the Procuring Entity may declare such bid as non-responsive without any forfeiture of bid securities and record reasons thereof.
- The procuring entity may offer the contract to next lowest bidder after due diligence in the context of financial difference between such two bids or may advertise procurement opportunity a fresh.
- After commencement of work by the successful bidder, the procuring entity may replace the Additional Security with a bank guarantee of the same amount from the scheduled bank; if the already deposited security is not in the form bank guarantee.
- The Additional Security shall be released to the contractor in four installments i.e. 1st installment of 25% to be released upon completion of 25% of the project, 2nd Installment of 25% to be released upon completion of 50% of the project, 3rd Installment of 25% to be released upon completion of 75% of the project and the 4th installment to be released after 100% completion of the project.
- All previous orders, instructions and regulations issued regarding additional security shall stand superseded.
- Copies of valid registration with PEC and KPRA. ii Copy of valid enlistment certificate of C&WD.
 - National Identity Card (CNIC photo copy).
 - Form H of the company/firm.
 - Detail of similar nature and other general works, in hands and completed during last five years supported by work orders and completion certificates duly attested from Executing Agencies concerned.
 - Machinery (Tools, Plants & Equipment etc) supported with the purchase documents as evidence of ownership.
 - Particular of technical Staff/engineers along with updated CVs and their agreement (for the current year) on stamp paper with the firm together with their qualification. Affidavit to the effect that the said personnel or their equivalent shall be made available for the job should also be given along with their registration number of PEC and contact numbers.
 - Financial soundness supported by annual audit reports for the current year. (vii) Tax Return Certificate for the CFY.
- Evaluation of Technical Proposal will be carried out with pass/ fail threshold in passing all the field including PEC registration in relevant code of CE-01 & CE-02 having Bridge Experience, Tax payer proof, relevant experience in past five years, performance, technical personnel, required equipment, financial status, auditors reports, managerial capabilities, litigation status etc. Evaluation criteria in this regard can be obtained from office of the undersigned on any working day in office hours or can be downloaded from the official website of C&WD. Technical Bid should in sealed envelope clearly marked: "Technical bid" addressed to the Executive Engineer Highway Division-I Bacha Khan Chowk Peshawar and shall be submitted through Pakistan Post/UMS/Courier before closing time.
